Fort Lauderdale, FL: Hector Picard, StarMark Karaoke, and Miller's Ale House joined forces to host the 1st Annual Karaoke For A Cause fundraiser for Racing For True Champions at Broward Children's Center.

Guests paid a \$20 entry fee (that included a free drink, light appetizers, and a raffle ticket) to Miller's Ale House in Fort Lauderdale. From 7 – 11 PM, guests enjoyed drinks, food, karaoke, and raffle prizes (from private yoga sessions, a 2-night stay at B Ocean, gift cards, and more!)

The crowd of just under 100 people spent the evening singing their favorite karaoke songs, mingling with BCC staff, families, and community partners, and raising money for a great cause.

The night, spearheaded by Hector Picard – the triathlete behind the Racing For True Champions series – raised a little under \$2,000, coming in \$1,853.77 for the Center.

Hector Picard, a bi-lateral amputee will continue his Racing For True Champions triathlon series this weekend in Miami. He will be racing for Logan, a 4-year-old boy with a heart condition known as Truncus Arteriosus, associated with C.H.A.R.G.E. syndrome.
